



General Information – Apples

Royal Gala

Scientific Name: *Malus domestica* 'Gala'

Originating in New Zealand Royal Gala is a white fleshed apple with a crisp and sweet to taste.

Available from February to July



Braeburn

Scientific Name: *Malus domestica* 'Braeburn'

The Braeburn apple has a sweet taste to start with a slightly tart finish. Braeburn has a white juicy and crisp flesh.

Available from March to August.



Fuji

Scientific Name: *Malus domestica* 'Fuji'

The Fuji is the sweetest tasting of apples with a crisp white flesh.

Available from March to August.





New Zealand Queen

Scientific Name: *Malus domestica 'Queen'*

New Zealand Queen is white fleshed sweet tasting apple, which is juicy and very crisp.

Available from March to June.



New Zealand Rose

Scientific Name: *Malus domestica 'Rose'*

New Zealand Rose is a very crisp and sweet apple with a distinctive pink reddish skin colour.

Available from March to July.



Granny Smith

Scientific Name: *Malus pimila*

The granny smith apple with its distinctive green skin and its refreshingly tart taste.

Available from April to June.
